Project Implementation update by DG InvestJigawa	DG InvestJigawa presented the Frilia technical committee report on frilia project implementation update. The presentation comprised of activities of the Frilia and Investment appraisal, number of appraised proposal, joint site inspections, stakeholder engagements. The committee responded by raising concerns on land allocated to investors that are not put to use.
